Polly L Arnold OBE FRS is the Crum Brown Chair of Chemistry at the University of Edinburgh. She holds degrees from Oxford and Sussex, and was a Fulbright postdoctoral fellow at MIT prior to returning to a lectureship in the UK in 1999. Her research is focused on exploratory synthetic chemistry of the heavy elements at the bottom of the periodic table, the f-block, and the development of homogeneous catalysis using the earth-abundant rare earths.
